- 1. Contributions Director Paula Blas stated that as of April 25, 2017, all agencies are current with their Fiscal Year 2017 employee and employer contributions.

- 3. Fiscal Year 2017 Retirees' Supplemental Benefits Director Blas stated that supplemental benefits for retirees and survivors for the month of March 2017 were paid.
- **4. Fiscal Year 2017 Medicare Reimbursements -** Director Blas stated that the Retirement Fund received the March 2017 allotment from the General Fund and reimbursements were processed accordingly.

VI. LEGAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

VII. TREASURER'S REPORT OF FINANCIAL STATUS

Treasurer Gerard Cruz reported that the current drawdown authorization is good up through September 30, 2017. Trustee David O'Brien mentioned that he sent out an article on Emergency Funds. Treasurer Cruz stated that we do have a provision in the law that allows for it, but our problem is that the Retirement Fund are net borrowers. Director Blas stated that it is called Emergency Reserve Fund. Chairman San Agustin stated that it is funded by investment performance. Chairman San Agustin stated that the law mandates that excess return, beyond the actuarial rate, be placed in a reserve account. Trustee O'Brien stated that the purpose of the Reserve Fund is for when we are in a hole. Treasurer Cruz asked when we can use the Reserve Fund. Director Blas stated there is a Reserve Account set up for each participant for their employer share for when they retire. Director Blas stated that she will have Legal Counsel look to see if it is mandated. Trustee O'Brien stated that it would be nice to know what we have to comply with, and also to know what other under funded Funds do in terms of an Emergency Reserve Fund.

A. Investment Committee

Vice Chairman Wilfred Leon Guerrero reported that the Investment Committee Meeting was held on April 27, 2017. The Committee reviewed and approved the Investment Committee Meeting Minutes of March 17, 2017. Vice Chairman Leon Guerrero stated that as of April 24, 2017, the size of the Retirement Fund's portfolio is \$1,686,949,160.

Next Quarterly Performance Meeting – Vice Chairman Leon Guerrero informed the Board that the next Quarterly Performance Meeting is scheduled for May 24 and 25, 2017.

Trustee O'Brien presented the Committee's April 2017 report to the Board of Trustees.
