DEFINED BENEFIT

IV. DIRECTOR'S REPORT - EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Financial Report

- 1. Contributions Director Paula Blas stated that as of October 25, 2019, all agencies are current with their Fiscal Year 2020 employee and employer contributions.
- 2. *Financial Statements* Director Blas stated that the books for the month ended September 30, 2019 are scheduled to close on November 8, 2019.
- 3. Fiscal Year 2020 Retirees' Supplemental Benefits Director Blas stated that supplemental benefits for retirees and survivors for the month of October 2019 will be paid at the end of the month.
- **4.** Fiscal Year 2020 Medicare Reimbursements Director Blas stated that the Retirement Fund received the October 2019 allotment from the General Fund and reimbursements were processed accordingly.
- 5. Fiscal Year 2020 Annual COLA Director Blas stated that the Annual COLA was released on October 25, 2019.

VI. TREASURER'S REPORT OF FINANCIAL STATUS

Treasurer Gerard Cruz stated that the Retirement Fund is operating within its current drawdown authority of up to \$5.5 Million monthly which continues through March 2020.

VII. STANDING COMMITTEE REPORTS

A. Investment Committee

Treasurer Cruz reported that the Investment Committee Meeting was held on October 28, 2019. The Committee reviewed and approved the Investment Committee Meeting Minutes of September 19, 2019. Treasurer Cruz stated that as of October 24, 2019, the size of the Retirement Fund's portfolio is \$1,998,995,935.

Recommendations for Board Action:

1. Fisher Investments

Treasurer Cruz stated that Maggie Ralbovsky of Wilshire Associates submitted her recommendation to terminate Fisher Investments' International Equity investments and transition the account into BlackRock EAFE Index Fund that's already set up in the Retirement Fund's portfolio, as soon as practically possible.

Treasurer Cruz stated that after a lengthy discussion and careful consideration, the Investment Committee recommends to maintain Fisher Investments as a manager, and to defund Fisher Investments' International Equity investments and transition the account as recommended by Wilshire.

Treasurer Gerard Cruz, seconded by Trustee Thomas San Agustin, moved to accept the Investment Committee's recommendation to keep Fisher Investments on Watch and to defund Fisher Investments' International Equity investments and transition the account into BlackRock EAFE Index Fund. Without objection, the motion passed.

Next Quarterly Performance Meeting – Treasurer Cruz informed the Board that the next Quarterly Performance Meeting is scheduled for November 13 and 14, 2019.

B. Members and Benefits Committee

Vice Chair Antolina Leon Guerrero presented the Committee's October 2019 report to the Board of Trustees.

Vice Chair Antolina Leon Guerrero, seconded by Trustee George Santos, moved to approve the recommendation of the Members and Benefits Committee contained on Pages 1 through 10, based on the Committee's review and findings during their meeting of October 11, 2019. Without objection, the motion passed.

DISABILITY CASE NO. 19-002

Director Blas stated that Disability Case No. 19-002 was disapproved at the August 29, 2019 Board Meeting. Director Blas stated that Robert Koss of the Guam Federation of Teachers (GRT) is requesting for a reconsideration of the case. Chairman Leon Guerrero referred Disability Case No. 19-002 to the Members and Benefits Committee.
