#### V. REVIEW AND FINDINGS

Based on our review and findings during our meeting of August 12, 2009, the following correspondence is recommended for **DISAPPROVAL** to the Board of Trustees.

1. COR 08-09 - Letter from Ms. Susan Kenney-Pfalzer, Micronesian Legal Services Corporation, RE: Application for Surviving Spouse Benefits for Defined Benefit Plan Member Samuel Leon Guerrero Borja by Rosa S. Borja.

Ms. Rosa S. Borja is claiming for surviving spouse benefits on behalf of Mr. Samuel LG Borja, a disability retiree whose date of death is October 24, 2004. The initial contact with the Fund was on June 29, 2006. A review of the documents submitted establishes the following:

- The documents from the Republic of Palau regarding marital status, indicates marriage is under local customs. (Question posed will this be acceptable under the United States and Guam marriage laws?)
- The date of marriage is indicated as January 18, 1986, the document was received by the Clerk of Court on October 26, 2006 (two years after his death).
- Ms. Borja was advised that the Fund's preliminary review of the documents and circumstances regarding dates and signature specimen of the deceased has not satisfied proof of marriage and entitlement for surviving spouse benefits.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Based on documentations and circumstances regarding dates and signature specimen of the deceased, the committee recommends that the Board of Trustee's <u>DISAPPROVE</u> the application for Surviving Spouse Benefits for Defined Plan Member Samuel Leon Guerrero Borja by Rosa S. Borja.
