#### V. REVIEW AND FINDINGS

Based on our review and findings during our meeting of February 09, 2011, the following correspondence is recommended for **DISAPPROVAL** to the Board of Trustees.

COR 10-001 – Fred A. Gofigan, SS# XXX-XX-3956, Governor's Office

**Request:** Mr. Gofigan has submitted his letter dated December 09, 2010, requesting consideration to be granted the opportunity to change previous NON-Base Option election from Exclusion to Inclusion and to apply for Education Credit for retirement purposes.

#### Discussion:

The Non-Base Option program in accordance with P.L. 19-19 and P.L. 20-04, offered two options for employees to select in which may or may not impact annuity benefits upon retirement are as follows:

*Inclusion*: Employees who elect this option **choose to contribute** 10.5% of their earnings identified such as overtime, bonuses, hazardous duty pay, night differential pay, lump sum annual leave pay, summer school pay, extra teaching assignment pay, and other salary for services rendered paid to members by the government, to be included as salary in achieving the Highest Average Annual Salary for retirement purposes. This would result with an increase in retirement annuity benefit payments.

Exclusion: Employees who elect this option choose not to contribute the additional 10.5% of their earnings identified such as overtime, bonuses, hazardous duty pay, night differential pay, lump sum annual leave pay, summer school pay, extra teaching assignment pay, and other salary for services rendered paid to members by the government, for retirement purposes. The end result is that the average annual salary is determined from Base salary earnings only in calculating retirement annuity benefit payments.

The Education Credit program in accordance with P.L. 20-04 allowed employees who obtained a graduate or undergraduate degree and meet the provision eligibility requirements, to submit application to claim and purchase credit for retirement purposes.

Application submission and payment arrangements must be made no later than June 14, 1989. Failure to do so within the time limitations shall be deemed as a forfeit of rights to take such educational credit.

#### **Recommendation:**

Our findings relative to the request to change Non-Base Option from Exclusion to Inclusion and to apply for Education Credit are as follows:

**Non-Base Option**: Mr. Gofigan completed his option form for submission to the Fund on June 09, 1989, indicating Exclusion for non-base pay and further acknowledging that such election is irrevocable for the duration of his Fund membership.

**Education Credit**: The service credit program ended on June 14, 1989 and does not allow for prospective application or service credit claims.

In conclusion of these findings, the recommendation is to, 1. Deny the request to change the non-base option on the basis that such election is irrevocable and, 2. Deny the request to apply for education credit on the basis that the application deadline ended on June 14, 1989 and service credit claims no longer exist pursuant to the enabling clause of P.L. 20-04, Section 6. (a) (6).
