V. ALTERNATIVE TO DISABILITY RETIREMENT PROCEDURES

As a result of the Board of Trustee's meeting of February 26 and February 27, 2009, the Members' and Benefits Committee members met to discuss the procedures currently in place for the application of disability retirement benefits.

To ensure that there is consistency and clarity, the Members' and Benefits Committee recommends revising the Recommendation for Disability Form (which is completed by the applicant's primary physician) and the medical evaluation form utilized by the independent physicians.

The Members' and Benefits Committee recommended creating a medical review team to consist of two independent licensed and practicing physicians to conduct the independent examinations and evaluations, and the Government of Guam Retirement Fund's medical consultant.

The Medical Review Team will review all disability applications and provide their recommendation to the GGRF Board.

The committee members have agreed to make amendments to the procedures as follows.

PROCEDURES FOR APPLICATION FOR DISABILITY RETIREMENT BENEFITS:

- 1. Applicant makes an inquiry. Personal information is obtained (Name and social security number).
- 2. Specialist retrieves file for review to determine eligibility requirements and statistical data.
- 3. Applicant is interviewed and advised of qualifications and procedures in the applications for Disability benefits.
- 4. The Recommendation for Disability form is provided to the applicant. This form is to be completed and submitted by the applicant's primary physician.
- 5. Upon receipt of the Recommendation for Disability form from the primary physician recommending that the applicant is disabled, an Application for Disability Retirement and a Department Head Statement is provided to the applicant.

The Application Form is then completed by the applicant - this form should be accompanied by personal documents (check stubs, birth certificates - the applicants, spouse and minor children - if applicable) as well as a marriage certificate.

Department Head Statement is to be completed by the immediate supervisor and signed by the Director of the employing agency with a request memo attached.

All medical records from physicians and specialists must be turned in.

- 6. Upon completion and submission, the applicant is then referred to two (2) licensed and practicing physicians selected by the Fund for independent medical examinations and evaluations. Under special circumstances, the board may refer the applicant to additional physicians.
- 7. Upon receipt of the two independent physician's medical examination and evaluations, along with all other pertinent medical records of the applicant, it is then submitted to the fund's medical consultant for review.
- 8. The medical consultant meets with the two independent doctors to discuss and review all the information provided. A recommendation is then decided upon.
- 9. The medical consultant's summary and recommendation is then presented at the Members' & Benefits Committee meeting. The committee will then review and ensure that all required documents are provided before a recommendation is made to forward the application to the Board of Trustees at their next regular meeting.
- 10. At the Board meeting, Members' & Benefits committee member Ms. Antolina S. Leon Guerrero will introduce the applicant's application and provide a summary to the board members for their discussion, review and action.
- 11. The applicant is then advised of the board of trustee's decision regarding their disability application.
