Discussion:

Ms. Perez was dismissed by her employer effective April 04, 2008 and submitted to the Fund on April 08, 2008 an application for withdrawal of retirement contributions. Her refund check was processed on April 18, 2008.

The Civil Service Commission ruled in her favor of the wrongful termination and adjudged that she be reinstated by her employer to the date of dismissal on April 08, 2008. The reinstatement personnel action was processed February 27, 2009.

Reference:

§8206. 4 G.C.A. Participation in Government of Guam Defined Contribution System; limiting participation in existing retirement system.

Beginning October 01, 1995, the Government of Guam Defined Contribution System shall be the single retirement program for all new employees whose employment commences on or after that date. No additional new employees may be admitted to the existing retirement system. Members of the existing retirement system whose employment continues beyond September 30, 1995, shall continue to contribute and participate in the existing system without change in provisions or benefits. Any employee who leaves government service after September 30, 1995, who is later reemployed by the Government of Guam shall be eligible for membership only in the Government of Guam Defined Contribution Retirement System; provided, that he or she shall be entitled to readmission to the existing retirement system in which he or she was originally a member, if such employee has not withdrawn his or her retirement contributions from the existing retirement system. However, if such employee has withdrawn his or her contribution from the existing retirement system, the readmission shall not be permitted and the employee will be entitled only to membership in the Government of Guam Defined Contribution System. Any employee who retires after September 30, 1995, and who later becomes reemployed by the Government of Guam, shall be entitled to readmission to the existing retirement system pursuant to 4 GCA §8121.

Discussion:

Ms. Castro applied for and received service credit to retire on December 31, 1999 with the Early Retirement Incentive Program (ERIP). Upon her reemployment on July 31, 2000, she enrolled membership into the Defined Benefit Plan to enhance her service credit for retirement purposes.

Upon her resignation effective August 11, 2008, she had requested for and was denied an application to withdraw retirement contributions for the reemployment period of July 31, 2000 through August 11, 2008.

Pursuant to 4 G.C.A. §8121. Suspension of Annuity Payment. A retired member who subsequently becomes an employee eligible for membership under §8106 of this Title prior to *January 1, 1999 shall, upon becoming so employed, have that member's right to received payment of that member's annuity suspended for the duration of that member's annuity provided by this Article, including automatic increases therein, shall be retained by that member. (*January 1, 1999 extended to January 1, 2000 by P.L. 25-90 for ERIP.)

By virtue of her suspension of annuity upon reemployment and submission of the Retirement Fund enrollment Application form; this is construed by retirement law as intent for membership status into the defined benefit plan to enhance total years of services for retirement purposes. Thus, the member will benefit by a recalculation and increase of annuity benefits. The Fund does not have a provision that allows retirees who are subsequently reemployed and who have resigned from such employment to apply and receive retirement contributions for incremental service periods of employment.

Members & Benefits Committee Recommendation:

The committee voted to affirm staff's recommendation and therefore recommends **DISAPPROVAL** of this request.
