V. REVIEW AND FINDINGS (Correspondences)

1. COR 04-1

RE: Glenna F. Woodruff

Request

To obtain credit under the Early Retirement Incentive Program (FRIP) Under PL 25-98.

Discussion:

Eligibility for ERIP requires that an applicant must have applied for such Credit from October 1, 1999 to January 7, 2000.

Findings:

Ms. Woodruff did not file an application during the eligibility period, therefore, we recommend **DISAPPROVAL** of this request.

2. **COR 04-2**

RE: Lorraine A. Underwood

Request:

To pay remaining balance of education credit identified by promissor y note no. 1720.

Discussion:

Promissory note executed on February 23, 1991. Bi-weekly payments discontinued in July 24, 2004. Since that time, a fire at the Retirement Fund destroyed her records and many years of miscommunications between Ms. Underwood and the Fund.

Findings:

Evidence suggests that administrative error may have occurred between Ms. Underwood and the Fund. However, Ms. Underwood is equally at fault under the terms and conditions outlined in the Promissory Note. Therefore, we recommend <u>CONDITIONAL APPRO VAL</u> subject to repayment of the balance within thirty (30) days of notice.

3. COR 04-3

RE: John R. Rider

Request:

Mr. Rider is petitioning the Fund for retirement service credits for contractual services he provided to the University of Guam from September 1991 through December 1993.

Discussion:

Pursuant to §8106. Same. Ineligible Persons. The following employees shall not be eligible for membership:

- (a) Persons whose services are compensated on a fee basis.
- (b) Independent contractors.
- (c) Persons whose employment is for a specific project.
- (d) Persons who are employed in the Senior Citizens Community Employment Program.

Findings:

Mr. Rider is ineligible for credit subject to the criteria pursuant to §8106,

Title 4, Guam Code Annotated, therefore, we recommend

DISAPPROVAL of this request.

4. COR 04-4 Robin P. Roberson

Request:

To obtain prorated interest payment on contributions withdrawn July 26,

2004 (for period October 2003 to June 2003).

Discussion:

§8164. Contribution Reserves and Accounts.

(a) Members Contribution Reserve. The amounts contributed by the members shall be credited to this reserve, together with regular interest thereon as herein provided. An individual account shall be maintained for each member, o which shall be credited the amounts of his contributions and interest thereon. Regular interest on such con tributious shall be credited annually, as of the close of each year an d shall be allowed only on the amount of the accumulated contributions standing to the credit of each member at the close of each year. A statement of account shall be issued to each member, annually, as of the end of each fiscal year, showing the amount of his accumulated contributions plus interest.

Findings:

The committee reaffirms the action of the Fund pursua_nt to §8164, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated and therefore recommends DIS_APPROVAL of

this request.

5. COR 04-5 RE: Julie Lujan-Torres

Request:

Mrs. Lujan-Torres has submitted her letter dated July 2 9, 2004, requesting to continue payment for Re-deposit service credit ident ified under promissory note no. 2982 executed December 15, 1995 with a completion

date of December 14, 2002.

Discussion:

Pursuant to the Regulations Concerning Claims To Obt ain Service Credits. 5.4 Installment Payment Limitations and Restrictions, members who have entered into a promissory note payment arrangement, a and due to financial reasons, may present written justification for externsion of the final payment date indicated on such promissory note. Members granted this request would require the Fund to calculate the appropriate interest incurred through the duration of the promissory note extended date of

final payment received by the Fund.

Findings:

Mrs. Lujan-Torres has made "good faith" efforts in livi ng up to her part of the agreement based on the circumstances presented an d therefore, we recommend APPROVAL of her request.

6. COR 04-6 RE: Rosario U. Perez

Request: To forgive overpayment owed due to administrative error.

Discussion: Overpayment of Minor Child Stipend for period November 30, 2001 to

June 30, 2004 in the amount of \$5,670.00.

Findings: Clearly the Fund made an error but the fact remains that \$5,670.00 was

overpaid. Therefore, the Committee reaffirms the action of the Fund and

recommends **DISAPPROVAL** of this request.
