V. REVIEW AND FINDINGS (CORRESPONDENCES)

1. COR 04-14 RE: Judy S. Flores

Request

To pay outstanding balances for re-deposit of service credit, identified in Promissory Note #1854 dated September 30, 1991.

Discussion

File documents indicate that Mrs. Flores

communicated with the Fund on April 24, 1996 in

efforts to transfer monies and pay in full the

computed balance due for re-deposit service credits. This information was forwarded to her account manager, although no records indicate receipt of

payment.

Findings

We recommend APPROVAL subject to repayment of the balance within thirty (30) days of notice.

2. COR 04-15 RE: Elizabeth Barrett-Anderson

Request

To extend the payment arrangements of promissory note # 4298 which commenced on PPE October 24. 1998 with a completion date of September 10, 2005

Discussion

With reference to Regulations Concerning Claims to Obtain Service Credits, Chapter V §5.4, this provision allows members who cannot afford the payment terms the opportunity to petition for approval of extending payment arrangements.

The committee has been consistent in granting such request to members who have submitted petitions to extend arrangements in advance of promissory note completion dates. All appropriate adjustments of

payment amount obligations are processed accordingly.

Findings

We recommend **APPROVAL** subject to the terms and conditions of extensions, with appropriate extended interest charges applied.

3. COR 04-16 RE: MARTHA A. RUBIC

Request

For consideration to apply for Educations Service Credits pursuant to §8111. or P.L. 20-04.

Discussion

Ms. Rubic has submitted her request to apply for Education Credit or Educational Training, whichever she may be entitled to. An evaluation of her employment history and retirement creditable services has been completed to determine eligibility and criteria requirements.

Education Credit: Members whom submitted applications during PL 20-4 were required to meet vesting status of actual government services to be eligible for credit. Anyone not meeting such criteria was deemed ineligible for credit consideration.

Educational Training: Credit is granted to applicants who have met the conditions of eligibility in providing evidence/documents that separation or termination from government services was specific to furthering educational pursuits, and classroom instructions at a duly recognized college or university commenced within ninety (90) days upon resignation from employment status.

A review of file documents and employment service calculations, has demonstrated that Ms. Rubic does not qualify for either credit on the basis of not meeting the criterion for Educational training or Education Credit pursuant to statute requirements and application submission deadline respectively.

Findings

Ms. Rubic is ineligible for credit for either the Education or Educational Training benefits of the Fund. Therefore, we recommend **DISAPPRVOAL** of this request.
