The Fund held its regular Investment Committee meeting on August 4, 2006. In attendance were Trustees Dr. Taylor, Gerard Cruz, Joe T. San Agustin and I. Other attendees were Paula Blas and Diana Bernardo.

The following items were discussed:

1. RFP - Global Custody Search

The RFP for Global Custody Search has been reviewed by the Investment Committee and is recommended for Board approval. If approved, it will be released within the next two weeks. At this time, the RFP is not ready for public release and should be kept confidential until appropriate public notification has been given.

The Committee reviewed and approved the June 2, 2006 and July 7, 2006 Investment Committee Minutes.

2. Funding of Managers

The Committee is considering the need for a Transition Manager. We are awaiting legal counsel's opinion regarding whether we can utilize one of our existing Investment Managers or if we need to issue an RFP.

The Committee met with Terry Dennison, our Investment Consultant, this week to discuss investment manager performances, implications of Bills 295 and 296 (Public Laws 28-135 and 28-136), recommendations for current managers, and new asset classes for consideration by the Committee and the Board.
