#### IV. OPEN DISCUSSION

- a. Status Current proposed legislation regarding investments.

  COMMITTEE DISCUSSION: Management has forwarded Board approved draft legislation amending Section 8158 the GGRF Senate Oversight Chairman for further action. Management expects public hearings to be scheduled before the end of the month of October. Management is awaiting draft legislation for proposed language for amendment to Section 8157 for submission to the Committee for its review and discussion.
- b. Status International Manager Contracts.

  <u>COMMITTEE DISCUSSION:</u> All contracts have been signed. Management is working with FHB and Mercer for the transition (See attachment # ). Issues needing resolution have been identified:
  - 1. Potential custodial issue regarding assets to be managed by Capital Int'l (Emerging Mkts).
  - 2. Treatment of dividends and capital gains (Mercer recommendation is re-investment).

Management will provide a status report on the progress of the transition.
